ET Australia Secondary College Scholarships

A scholarship is money set aside which can assist a family to pay school fees. Scholarships are available for eligible Year 7 to 12 students. The application process is simple. The majority of scholarship applications are successful.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible an applicant needs to demonstrate financial hardship, taken into consideration will be the student's:

- enthusiasm to school work.
- consistent attendance and;
- a willingness to learn, combined with a drive to achieve.

Scholarship Conditions

- Scholarships are to remain confidential.
- Scholarships can be for up to 50% of the current school fees, but do not cover any other costs.
- Parents/carers are expected to pay the first 50% of the school fees and the scholarship will cover the remaining amount, where the student's effort and attendance levels are deemed satisfactory.
- Scholarship holders are expected to participate fully in school life.
- No family or student may hold more than one scholarship.
- A student who holds a scholarship is not eligible to receive a further sibling discount.
