What are the advantages of self-paced learning?

This style of learning allows you the freedom to work through your studies at times that are convenient to you. Whilst you will have a timeframe in which to complete, you can choose when to study to meet those timeframes.

There's no need to find time to get to classes, or slow down and wait for other students.

If you are someone who learns at a fast pace you have the opportunity to gain competency and finish your studies quickly. However, if you are someone who learns at a slower pace you have the opportunity to absorb information without being pushed ahead when you may not be ready.

You can start and stop as time allows in your daily routines. You simply recommence where you left off, while still meeting the due dates. Learning and qualification outcomes are the same for both self-paced learners and classroom learners.

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You will need access to a digital device with access to Microsoft Word, Outlook (or similar) and the internet. Other software applications may be required if you are undertaking a business program but these will be discussed with you prior to enrolment.

You will need a supportive employer. Self-paced learning is only available to existing workers who have the opportunity to access workplace resources required for learning / assessment. There will be occasions when you will be required to complete an on the job assessment activity, which may require you to gain access to workplace resources. For this reason it is imperative to have the support of your employer. Our staff member will advise you as to the type of workplace resources required, this will be done prior to enrolment.

How much will my training cost?
